

# Admission Procedure For Class 11<sup>th</sup>

## General Instructions:

- Admission starts immediately after the declaration of high school results by the respective boards
- Written entrance exam of subjects as per stream opted by the student for class 11<sup>th</sup> will be taken based on the high school syllabus
- Admission will be given based on the entrance exam result and availability of seats on 'first come first serve' basis
- Parents must bring their child along with themselves when visiting the school for taking admission form
- Admission process continues till the last date of registration as declared by the UP Board (*Generally up to 30<sup>th</sup> September of that session*)

## Documents required:

- Original TC issued by the previous school (*If the last attended school is other than district Ayodhya, the TC counter signed by DIOS of that district is compulsory*)
- Original and photocopy of class 10<sup>th</sup> mark sheet
- Aadhar card/ Birth certificate of the child
- Aadhar card/ Government approved ID of father
- Aadhar card/ Government approved ID of mother
- Aadhar card/ Government approved ID of the legal guardian in case of adopted child
- Latest photograph (*not older than 3 months*) of the child
- Latest photograph (*not older than 3 months*) of father
- Latest photograph (*not older than 3 months*) of mother
- Latest photograph (*not older than 3 months*) of the legal guardian in case of adopted child

## Fees:

- Annual fee is taken quarterly (*i.e. in 4 installments*)
- 1<sup>st</sup> installment (*including the admission and miscellaneous fees*) must be submitted at the time of admission
- Each fee installment must be submitted by the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the starting of that quarter
- All 4 installments must be paid even in case of late admissions
- **Board registration fee and the examination fee (as declared by the UP Board) will be charged separately at the time of board registration**

## Notes:

- Visit school for taking admission form
- Above instructions are only the general guidelines for the ease of parents
- Instructions given at the school must be considered final
